



Stud-Link Chain Purchasing Tips

STEP

1

Quantity

How many lengths of chain do you require?

You can check the readings report from the dockyard to determine how many lengths of chain you require. (27.5m lengths are standard.)

STEP

2

Chain Size

What diameter of chain do you need?

STEP

3

Grade of Steel

You can determine the grade of steel you require for your order from the previous Test Certificate. The Test Certificate will show the approved classification society from Lloyds Register and other class societies to be either grade U2 or U3

STEP

4

Accessories

Do you need to add Shackles and swivel forerunners to your order?

If so, what type of swivel is required?

STEP

5

Timescales

Placing your order well in advance of the deadline does open up the possibility of your product being sent by the sea which is the most cost-effective mode of transportation. Alternatively, an early order will still reduce costs by road or air.
